**Scholarship Deadline:**

This scholarship was started by the Foundation of Mayland Community College for the purpose of increasing student scholarship opportunities at Mayland Community College. ### **Scholarship Criteria:**

- Student must be enrolled in field of study or transfer courses (not doing pre-major work)
- Student must have a minimum 2.0 GPA

- Independently answer the four questions on application with each answer being 200 words or less (words will be counted)

- Be sure to have fun answering the questions – creative, out of the box, off the wall answers are key!!!
- Submit application along with LEO copy of your transcript
