

POTENTIAL WORK-STUDY STUDENT INFORMATION SHEET

All students receiving Federal PELL Grant benefits are eligible to participate in the on-campus work-study program. The Federal Work-study allotment has a limited amount of money to be awarded each academic year, therefore the number of awards made will be limited. Students will be selected based upon the following criteria; 1) earliest date received of completed application, 2) criteria of student skills and hours available matched with open positions, 3) additional awards are made as funds becomes available.
