The purpose of advisory committees at Mayland Community College is to give advice to college personnel regarding the initiation, implementation and evaluation of educational programs to ensure the appropriateness and relevance of programs.

Advisory committees are valued by the college as a primary vehicle for gaining advice from the community persons and organizations which are most affected by the content and/or outcomes of the different college programs. Members of advisory committees will be identified and appointed by the relevant department personnel and administrator, on the basis of the particular purposes and intended outcomes of the reviews involved.

The Board of Trustees shall receive a report of each advisory committee no later than the regularly scheduled October Board meeting.
