The Board of Trustees of Mayland Community College directs the President to put in place academic probation/suspension and withdrawal procedures for students enrolled in curriculum programs that realize the following outcomes:

1. Programmatic Excellence: High standards within curriculums need to be reinforced by a college infrastructure that requires, supports, and promotes student achievement.
2. Student Support: Students should be sent strong and clear messages about programmatic progress, otherwise they cannot assess their capabilities and make necessary adjustments (e.g., seek help, make behavioral changes.) An academic warning system should be in place to ensure that students are connected with relevant and useful college student support resources.
3. Prudent Use of Federal, State and Local Resources: Our students' educations are being subsidized in large part by outside entities. It is incumbent upon MCC to ensure that these resources are being effectively utilized in the support of students who are ready, willing and able to benefit from the services provided by MCC.
