AUTHORITY: NCGS 115D-20 (7)

A student may be dismissed from a program if, in the opinion of the Instructor, Academic Dean, Dean of Students and Vice President of Instruction and Student Development, the student's behavior and/or performance conflict with the safety, purpose or administration of the classroom, clinical setting, internship, cooperative education, or other learning experience of a program. If the student in question is enrolled in a continuing education class, the instructor, the Campus Dean, the Associate Vice President for Continuing Education, and the Vice President of Instruction and Student Development would make the determination to dismiss a student. Unacceptable physical or emotional conditions as demonstrated in the classes of the program or related educational situations may also be grounds for dismissal.

The student shall retain the right to appeal such a decision through the Student Grievance procedure.
