AUTHORITY: NCGS 115D.21

The Board of Trustees of Mayland Community College authorizes the President to establish and implement regulations, guidelines and procedures for the management of parking and traffic at the College and access roads leading to the College.

1. All regulations, guidelines and procedures shall be in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 115D-21 of the North Carolina General Statutes and other applicable local, state or federal ordinances.
2. Users of College streets, roads, driveways, and access roads shall do so in a manner consistent with applicable local, state or federal ordinances.
3. The President shall have the right to deny use of College streets, roads, driveways and access roads to any individual, group or organization deemed to be in violation of College parking and traffic regulations, or for any other reason.
4. The speed limit on all College streets, roads, driveways and access roads shall be twenty (20) miles per hour.
5. Reasonable provisions shall be made for the towing or removal of unattended vehicles found to be in violation of College parking and traffic regulations.
6. All rules, regulations and ordinances adopted pursuant to this policy shall be posted and/or made available to all students, employees and visitors to the College.
