AUTHORITY: Campus Crime Awareness/Security Act of 1990; SACS 3.11.2

It is the policy of Mayland Community College to comply with the provisions of the Campus Crime Awareness and Security Act of 1990. To that end, the College will maintain and make available a Campus Security Plan that addresses the following elements:

- a. Procedures for students and employees to report criminal activities.
- b. Security at campus facilities.
- c. Availability and authority of campus security personnel.
- d. Programs available to inform students about security and the prevention of crime.
- e. Recording of acts of crime through local law enforcement agencies; and
- f. Manufacture, possession, use and sale of alcohol or drugs.

The College will prepare, publish, and distribute annual statistical reports that identify the occurrence of campus crimes, and the number of campus arrests for crimes specified in the Campus Crime Awareness and Security Act of 1990.

The Campus Security Plan and statistical reports will be made available to students, employees, prospective students and employees, the higher education community, and the general public through annual publication in the college catalog, student handbook, and on the College website.
