The Board of Trustees directs the President to develop an inclement weather procedure that recognizes:

1. classes must be held in order to meet course competencies,
2. due to unpredictable weather patterns in the mountains, conditions may be drastically different within the Mayland service area,
3. college staff, faculty and students may travel great distances to attend work and school,
4. staff, faculty and student safety should be predominant in any decision to cancel or delay classes of the college, and
5. correct information about the operations of the college must be provided to faculty, staff and students in a timely manner.
