It is the intent of the Board of Trustees of Mayland Community College to promote the health, well-being and safety of students, faculty, staff and campus visitors of Mayland Community College. To address this commitment, smoking and the use of tobacco and smokeless tobacco products is prohibited on all college properties, including but not limited to academic and auxiliary buildings, sidewalks, green spaces, parking lots, roadways and all vehicles.

The trustees direct the President to develop a procedure for violation of this policy in accordance with college disciplinary measures for employees and students. For visitors, enforcement of this policy is the responsibility of the person(s) coordinating the visit or the person(s) responsibility for the facility or area in use at the time.

The success of this tobacco-free policy depends on the thoughtfulness, consideration, and cooperation of tobacco users and non-tobacco users. All students, employees, and visitors are responsible for adhering to this policy.
