Eligibility Requirements:

This application must be submitted no later than 11:59p.m. EST, April 13, 2018. Required documentation is due on or before 4:00p.m. EST, April 13, 2018.

- Students must be enrolled for a minimum of six (6) credit hours for each semester awarded.
 - Students enrolled part-time (6-11 credit hours) may not be eligible for some scholarships or may receive only partial awards for others.
- Students must submit the 2018-19 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by the deadline date.
- Be a U.S. citizen or national; be a U.S. permanent resident or other non-eligible citizen; or be a citizen of the Freely Associated States.

- **Current transcripts must be submitted or already on file by the scholarship deadline date.**
