Why study information technology? There are plenty of solid reasons to consider an IT career. This is a vibrant field with work in diverse areas such as networking, system support, programming, software development, data storage, cloud and virtualization tools, information security, and other emerging technologies.

1. Dynamic Field. Information Technology is an exciting field that does not get stagnant. New technologies evolve. IT workers often get to work with cutting edge tools to support businesses as they incorporate new and dynamic computer systems into the course of everyday operations. According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, median annual salaries for IT professions in 2020 ranged from \$48,380 for computer user support specialists to \$99,340 for computer systems analysts.
