The Board authorizes the President to establish and implement a professional development program that, at a minimum, provides for:

1. Opportunities to strengthen and improve the knowledge, skills and abilities necessary for employees to perform their assigned job functions at an optimum level;
2. Education for new employees in how to perform their jobs, orientation to the College's operations and training for current employees in how to teach new employees;
3. Encouragement to all employees to improve their skills and increase their job knowledge through a Performance Management Plan of professional development that supports their assigned job function as part of the College's mission and purposes; and
4. Expenditures of funds, subject to availability, that support this Policy's goals and aims.
